


Alluring Shapes

This butterfly brooch in yellow gold is set with a 5.30-carat cushion-cut Mandarin garnet, paired with yellow and pink sapphires, red spinets, Paraiba and green tourmalines, tsavorite garnets, emeralds, lapis lazuli, onyx, carnelian, rubellite and brilliant-cut diamonds.
